

Cancer support house to stay open, for now

HealthAlliance Hospital network plans to move the program to medical village at former Kingston Hospital

KINGSTON, N.Y. » In a reversal, HealthAlliance Hospital's cancer support program will remain open and continue at a Mary's Avenue house until it moves into the former Kingston Hospital, which is being turned into a medical village, according to a statement sent to program participants and the hospital owner.

The pending closing of the HealthAlliance Hospital's Herbert H. and Soda P. Reuner Cancer Support House, which is up for sale, had generated an abundance of reaction in the form of emails sent to the Freeman during the week. The hospital's parent company had said it would continue the service with "minor" reductions at a different spot in the city, without specifying when and where.

The Oncology Support Program will now remain at the 80 Mary's Ave. facility until it moves to the medical village location on Broadway in Kingston, according to the statement sent to participants.
